PROFILE

Kasturba Gandhi College for Women was established in 1973 by the Osmania Graduates' Association under the patronage of the Exhibition Society with a noble intention of making higher education accessible to all strata of women in a sprawling campus of 3.85 acres of land in the centrally located Marredpally area of Secunderabad. Since then the college has progressed in terms of infrastructure, number of courses offered and student strength. The college has now emerged as a much sought after and leading institution of higher learning in the twin cities with a strength of nearly 3000 students and over 90 teaching staff with 22 departments. It was first accredited with 'A' Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2005. In March 2017 the college was re-accredited with an 'A' Grade by NAAC upholding the position it achieved as a premier institution of higher learning. The college offers Undergraduate Programs and Post Graduate Programs and we have transitioned smoothly to CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) from the academic year 2016-17.

The curriculum is enriched with the Add-on courses like Personality Development, Employability Advantage, and Spoken English etc. at Undergraduate level. Subject related clubs and general clubs were initiated in the college for experiential learning and creativity. The club activities have shown good learning outcomes, helping students with practical orientation and informal learning, giving them hands-on experience. Weekly assemblies are conducted for better networking and togetherness in the college which is organized by one department every week, on rotation.

The institution is ranked 3rd best among colleges in Telangana State and 36th at all India level by EDUCATION WORLD Magazine. The college is Ranked consistently in top 100 colleges at all INDIA level by INDIA TODAY Magazine. This achievement is due to the collective efforts of the Management, Principal, well qualified Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff and Students. Kasturba Gandhi College for Women has become a destination of higher learning due to the experienced and well qualified faculty members most of whom hold a Doctoral Degree.

Sponsors

The Osmania Graduates' Association (OGA), the largest Alumni Association in Asia, was formed in 1932 with the aim of promoting socio-economic development and education in the state of Telangana. The Exhibition Society, an offshoot of the OGA was established in 1938 to conduct the annual All India Industrial Exhibition and generate funds. These funds are used jointly by OGA and Exhibition Society to set-up and manage educational institutions. Our college is one among the eighteen institutions run by OGA and Exhibition Society.

Rules and Regulations

Attendance Requirements

1. Students are required to have a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject.
2. If a candidate fails to secure 75% attendance, the college has the authority to withhold her

Examination form and prevent her from appearing for the University Examination.

3. No student will be allowed to absent herself from the college without leave, for which an application must be submitted on the first day of her return to the college. Application for leave on grounds of ill-health must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate.
4. If any student is continuously absent for a period of more than one month she should seek permission from the Principal and submit a letter from her parents stating the reasons for her absence.
5. If any student discontinues her studies without informing the Principal, she will be liable to pay the total fees for the course.
6. Parents are requested to constantly monitor the attendance of their wards.

Please note

1. All students should be regular and punctual to classes. Late comers will lose their attendance.
2. Students are expected to be neat and clean. Their dress must be simple and must conform to the standards of modesty maintained by the Institution.
3. Students are not allowed to see any visitors during the working hours.
4. Students are advised to read the notices displayed on the notice board.
5. Students are not allowed to use cell phones in the college premises.

College Timings

The Classes begin at 9:40 AM and end at 3:10 PM on all days except Monday. On Mondays the classes will begin at 9:50 AM after the General Assembly and 10 minutes will be added to each class. Classes will end at 3:20 PM on Mondays.

General Assembly

There will be an assembly session every Monday morning from 9:30 AM to 9:50 AM. The assembly session will be conducted by departments on rotation. The assembly program includes a weekly news roundup, role plays and subject related updates. The Principal also makes important announcements during the assembly. All students should attend the assembly every Monday. In the event of Monday being a holiday the assembly will be conducted on Tuesday.

Under this scheme, a meritorious female child can avail education, mentoring and scholarship services from the government in order to gain knowledge in the technical field.

The National Policy for Women

This policy was framed to safeguard the safety of women with the help of One Stop Centres, Women Helpline, Mahila Police Volunteers, Panic buttons in mobiles etc.

Swayam Prabha

Swayam Prabha Scheme allows **32 Direct-to-Home (DTH) Television Channels** for providing high quality educational content to all teachers, students and citizens across the country. The channel will broadcast programs for school and university students.

State Govt. Schemes for Women and Girls (Govt. of Telangana)

The Girl Child Protection Scheme is aimed at preventing gender discrimination by empowering and protecting rights of girl children through direct investment from the Government.

Kalyana Lakshmi/Shaaadi Mubarak

To alleviate financial distress of SC/ST and minority families the Government sanctions a one-time financial assistance of Rs. 51,000 at the time of marriage for brides who are residents of Telangana State.

Arogya Lakshmi

The Telangana government provides one nutritious meal every day to pregnant and lactating women and children below the age of six through Anganwadi centres.
